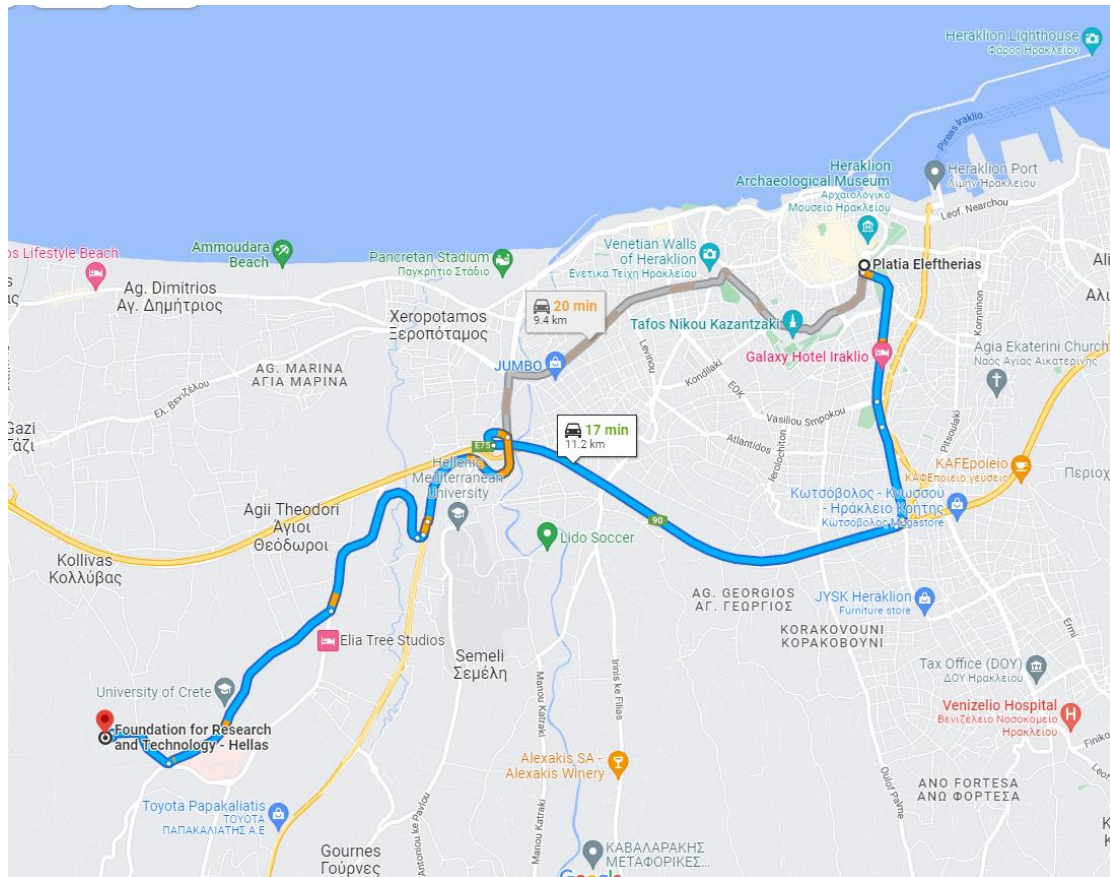

## FORTH FACILITIES



The facilities of FORTH ([www.ics.forth.gr](http://www.ics.forth.gr)) are located just outside the city of Heraklion (N.Plastira 100, Vassilika Vouton). Here is a map of the itinerary from the city center:



### Transportation options

There are two main bus stops in the center. The first bus stop is right next to Astoria Capsis Hotel. There are also other suggested hotels that are quite close to the bus stops. The route takes about 40 minutes by bus (heading ITE or PAGNI) and the ticket costs 1,50 € (blue ticket). Ticket vending machines are located next to most bus stations in the centre but you can also buy from most kiosks around the city. Please keep in mind that city traffic may affect departure and arrival times. In addition, you can get a taxi which takes no more than 20 minutes, depending on the traffic, and costs approximately 12 € from Eleftherias Square, plus €2 for call service. You can call (+30) 2810 321330 or (+30) 2810 210102 for a taxi.

All Venue Rooms are located at the Central Building, straight ahead from the entrance.

## WHAT TO DO IN HERAKLION

Heraklion is a city full of history and things to do. The most famous attraction is the **palace of Knossos** located outside of the city and the **Archeological Museum** in the city center, where in both places you can watch the Minoan life unravel. Another important museum is the **Historical Museum**, also in the city center, which is the perfect place to have a look at the more recent history of the town. Also, the **Natural History Museum of Crete** will give you a great taste of the local fauna and flora. By the sea you can also visit the **fortress of 'Koules'**, and you can **take a walk** anytime **on the Venetian Walls or besides and under them**, visiting the bastions and the city gates. On the bastion of **Martinengo** you will also find the **tomb of Nikos Kazantzakis**

The city, being on a crossroad of the Mediterranean history for centuries, is filled with sights (archeological sites, Venetian and Turkish buildings, churches, fountains) with historical significance that are scattered throughout the city.
